- Estimated value over \$1 million;
- High level of community interest or other exceptional interest; or
- Highly complex or technical in nature, or contract terms & conditions that are non-standard or complex.

High profile contracting initiatives are identified as Select, Individual or Consent. Select high profile contracting initiatives require both pre-and post-solicitation B Session briefings to City Council. Select initiatives are identified based on the following criteria: financial impact (value over \$25 million); contract term (over 10 years); policy/public safety implications; community/stakeholder impact or interest and/or professional judgement.

Individual and Consent high profile contracting initiatives require both a pre- and post-solicitation briefing to the Audit and Accountability Committee. Projects with more significant dollar values, policy issues and/or community interest are identified as Individual high profile projects while Consent projects are routine in nature with minimal policy impacts.

A biannual forecast of high profile contracting initiatives is presented to both City Council and the Audit and Accountability Committee.

This report only includes Discretionary Contracts. No low-bid type contracts are listed in this report. All items listed will be brought forward to City Council for approval.
