City Seeks Applicants for the
VIA Metropolitan Transit Authority Board of Trustees

SAN ANTONIO (May 6, 2019) – The City of San Antonio continues to seek applicants to fill one (1) slot on the VIA Metropolitan Transit Authority Board of Trustees. The term of office expires December 31, 2019. The VIA Metropolitan Transit Authority Board of Trustees is comprised of 11 members, of which five (5) members are appointed by the City Council for staggered two-year terms. Members must be qualified voters residing within the VIA Metropolitan Transit Service Area.

Members receive compensation of \$50.00 per meeting of the Board attended, not to exceed five meetings or a maximum of \$250.00 any calendar month. Board meetings are held on the fourth Tuesday of the month at 5:00 PM at the VIA Metro Center.

The application deadline has been extended through Monday, May 20, 2019 by 5:00 p.m.
